- 1. Public Comment -**
 - a. No public comments were presented.
- 2. December 17, 2018 Minutes**
 - a. Minutes were approved.
- 3. Consider Coordination Agreement**
 - a. The Committee review the Coordination Agreement between the Salinas Valley Basin GSA and the ASGSA. The agreement is a required element of SGMA, and was drafted to include the formation and authority for the Management Area of the ASGSA within the Arroyo Seco Cone and Forebay Subbasins. Following introduction of the agreement and a discussion considering the agreement's content, the Committee recommended the Board of Directors approve the agreement acknowledging there may be modifications requested by the SVBGSA.
- 4. Groundwater Sustainability Plan Update**
 - a. Status of the GSP was discussed. TODD Groundwater plans to present the first 3 chapters of the plan in February.
- 5. Consider Advisory Committee Membership**
 - a. Committee discussed adding new members to the committee. The committee has sought additional representation from the City of Greenfield. Ms. Lerner volunteered to review previous Board action and formation documentation. The Committee also suggested to consider adding a process to remove committee members who repetitively miss meetings. General consensus was to proceed forward with adding additional members to the Committee.

BACKGROUND

TODD Environmental (TODD) has been developing the Arroyo Seco GSA (ASGSA) GSP since the summer of 2018, and presented the first GSP workshop to the Board of Directors (BOD) in November of 2018. TODD has completed draft review versions the first 3 GSP chapters for the Arroyo Seco groundwater basin. These chapters will be presented to the ASGSA Advisory Committee on February 14, 2019 or can be viewed using the following link:

BUDGET DISCUSSION:

TODD provide the Advisory Committee a presentation on focused on several key issues for the Committee to consider. These include discussions for the following GPS components:

- Water Budget development
- Management Area considerations
- Minimum Threshold Criteria
 - **Groundwater Elevations**
 - **Groundwater Storage**
 - **Seawater Intrusion**
 - **Subsidence**
 - **Water Quality**
 - **Inter-connected Surface Water**

- **Groundwater-Department Ecosystems**

- Duration of low groundwater events

Our current proposed methods will be to develop draft GSP chapters for the Advisory Committee to review, prior to presenting the chapters to the BOD. Public comments will be received following each presentation allowing the public to provide direct input into the GPS process. One final round of GPS comments is anticipated in the fall to allow for creating a final draft plan ready to submit to the Department of Water Resources in January of 2020.

Due to the size and scheduling considerations Chapter 3 will be forwarded in sections to the Advisory Committee ahead of the February meeting.

The ASGSA General Manager has reviewed this report and recommends that the Advisory Committee provide comment and recommend the draft GPS chapters be forwarded to the Board of Directors for their consideration.
