Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes

March 14, 2018

1. **Public Comment -**
 - a. No public comments were presented.
2. **Approval of February 23, 2018 Meeting Minutes**
 - a. Committee approved the 2/23/18 meeting minutes.
3. **Management Area Update**
 - a. Committee received verbal report from the ASGSA General Manager regarding the status of negotiations to form a Management Area (MA) that would include Clark Colony and petitioned lands that were submitted to the Department of Water Resources to form the ASGSA. In addition, several committee members reported that most if not all of the “holes” in the proposed management area had been addressed. The committee suggested a new map be developed.
4. **ASGGSA Participation in the Salinas Basin Ag Water Association – Project Development Committee.**
 - a. The SBAWA has requested two property owners from the ASGSA and the potential management area participate in a series of facilitated project development meetings.
 - b. The Committee nominated Allan Panziera and Jim Thorpe, both candidates requested the opportunity to consider the nomination.
5. **GSP Status Update**
 - a. The Committee recommended that the ASGSA Board of Directors consider developing their own Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP). Discussion followed noting the general lack of progress made in negotiations with the SVBGSA for the development of a management area, and recommended the ASGSA consider two tracks forward for developing an ASGSA GSP.
6. **Next Steps**
 - a. The committee requested the resolutions of support from the City of Greenfield and the letters of support from Clark Colony be presented to the ASGSA to publicly demonstrate local support for the development of the ASGSSA and the desire to develop a local GSP to manage groundwater in the ASGSA, Clark Colony and the petitioned lands.
