## **Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes**

March 13, 2019

- 1. Public Comment -**

The General Manager provided an oral report on the status of the ASGSA GSP. The consultant team was working on the next section of technical work and was developing the Arroyo Seco region water balance and modeling configuration. The Advisory Committee (AD Comm) received the report and has informed that TODD Environmental would be present at the April meeting. There was also a recommendation for TODD to reach out to individual property owners for well extraction data. The outreach will require coordination with AD Comm members. There was also a request for additional documentation to track comments from the Ad Comm relating to the GSP presentations.
