

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-82

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENFIELD AMENDING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING, DATED JULY 1, 2008 WITH THE GREENFIELD POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (GPOA) REQUIRING ALL MEMBERS REDUCE THEIR SALARY BY 5% BY CONTRIBUTING FIVE PERCENT (5%) OF THE NINE PERCENT (9%) TOWARD THE EMPLOYEE'S PORTION OF THEIR RETIREMENT FOR THE PERIOD FROM AUGUST 29, 2010 – SEPTEMBER 3, 2011

Whereas, the City of Greenfield has a need to reduce the General Fund expenditures by no less than Five Percent (5%); and

Whereas, the City of Greenfield and the Greenfield Police Officers Association have bargained in good faith to reduce the General Fund personnel expenditures by Five Percent (5%); and

Whereas, the City of Greenfield provided the GPOA with the option of either making a Five Percent (5%) PERS contribution or taking a Five Percent (5%) wage reduction; and

Whereas, the GPOA has chosen the option to contribute Five Percent (5%) of the Nine Percent (9%) employee contribution rate.

Therefore, both parties hereby agree that all members of the GPOA shall contribute Five Percent (5%) towards their retirement costs. The GPOA contribution shall be for twenty-six (26) consecutive pay periods beginning 12:01 a.m. August 29, 2010 (pay day of September 17, 2010).

PASSED AND ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Greenfield duly held on the 14th day of September, 2010, by the following vote:


