CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS AND CURB RAMPS BEGINS IN GREENFIELD

MONTEREY COUNTY - Caltrans announced today that roadwork is underway near Greenfield on Oak, Elm and Walnut Streets to construct sidewalks and curb ramps in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Construction will consist primarily of shoulder, ramp and occasional lane closures and will take place Mondays through Thursdays from 8 am to 4 pm with no ramp closures on Fridays. Up to 10 minutes delays are anticipated with work expected to be complete in early June, weather permitting.

“This project will improve mobility and safety for Salinas Valley residents,” said District 5 Director Rich Krumholz.

This project has support from the Greenfield City Council, the Greenfield Unified School District, Monterey County Supervisor Simon Salinas, the Transportation Agency for Monterey County and other local stakeholders.

The contractor for this \$349,000 project is Dreambuilder of Placentia, CA.
