COMMENTS FROM CITY COUNCIL

Councilmember Rodriguez stated that as an alternate member to an agency appointed by the City Council, such as Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority, it was very important to be informed so that when the member could not attend the alternate could be fully informed.

Councilmember Moreno stated that she was glad to see that the property on 7th Street was getting cleaned up.

Councilmember Walker stated that he was glad that both the code enforcement and budget and finance board members had been appointed.

Mayor Huerta announced that there would be a regional AMBAG meeting in Gonzales tomorrow night.

City Manager Stanton stated that the City had been contacted regarding a grant that the City had been granted previously, \$250,000, and that it needed to be spent and asked that the Council think of ways on how to spend it. The grant must be spent on recreational facilities. She also stated that the Mayor and she had been working with the property owners and LAFCo regarding the annexation and they should be going before LAFCo sometime in June with Council consent. She reported what was going on with the Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority regarding the County wanting to get out of the Authority, which would impact all members of the Authority. She also reported in regards to the financial situation of the Greenfield Fire District. She discussed the creation of a special events committee.
