



# **Administrative Regulations for Implementation of Chapter 5.28 – Medical Marijuana Facilities Regulatory Permit**

## **Supplemental Information**

Section 8 of the Administrative Regulations for a Medical Marijuana Facilities Regulatory Permit requires the submittal of “evidence that the organization operating the medical marijuana facility is organized as a bona fide non-profit cooperative, affiliation, association, or collective of persons comprised exclusively and entirely of qualified patients and the primary caregivers of those patients in strict accordance with the Compassionate Use Act of 1996, the Medical Marijuana Program Act and the 2008 Attorney General Guidelines.”

To provide documentation that medical marijuana plants and products will be cultivated, produced, and distributed only through a non-profit cooperative, affiliation, association, or collective closed-loop system, in this section of the application also identify:

- (1) The name(s) and address(es) of the cooperative(s), affiliation(s), association(s), or collective(s) with which the applicant is affiliated, including written documentation of an established business relationship;
- (2) The number of members of each such cooperative, affiliation, association, or collective;
- (3) The number of marijuana plants to be grown in the cultivation facility; and
- (4) The name(s) and address(es) of the cooperative(s), affiliation(s), association(s), or collective(s) to whom cultivated and/or manufactured medical marijuana products will be distributed.
