CITY STREET TREES

The trees listed below are the only trees that may be planted in a City right-of-way.

1	<i>Pyrus kawakamii</i>	Evergreen Pear
2	<i>Liquidambar styracifula</i>	Sweet Gum
3	<i>Geijera parviflora</i>	Australian Willow
4	<i>Cercidium praecox</i>	Sonoran Palo Verde Tree
5	<i>Chionanthus retusus</i>	Chinese Fringe Tree
6	<i>Cotinus coggygia</i>	Smoke Tree
7	<i>Fraxinus americana</i>	White Ash 'Autumn Purple'
8	<i>Gleditsia triacanthos inermis</i>	Honeylocust 'Shademaster'
9	<i>Koelreuteria paniculata</i>	Golden Rain Tree
10	<i>Lagerstroemia x fauriei</i>	Crape Myrtle 'Tuscarora' or 'Muskoqee'
11	<i>Sophora japonica 'Regent'</i>	Japanese Pagoda Tree
12	<i>Ginkgo biloba</i>	Ginkgo Tree, male species only, 'Autumn Gold' or 'Fairmont'
13	<i>Platanus x acerfolia</i>	London Plane Tree 'Bloodgood'

Trees must be planted 2 1/2 - 3 feet from the back of the sidewalk. Any tree less than 2 1/2 feet from the sidewalk will not be accepted.

All trees must be braced with a 2 X 2 inch redwood stake or a steel stake. Stakes must be 1 1/2 feet in the ground and must be at least 5 feet above ground. All trees are required to have root guards installed.

*** NO FINAL INSPECTION OR CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL AFTER THE REQUIRED TREE(S) HAVE BEEN PLANTED.***
