**RECEIVE UPDATE ON THE ARROYO SECO GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY AGENCY DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCE GRANT APPLICATION AND PROVIDE STAFF DIRECTION**

Staff report was given by General Manager Weeks. He updated the Board regarding the approved grant application for \$3 million dollars. He stated that the Salinas Valley Basin GSA would receive approximately \$2.5 million and the Arroyo Seco GSA would receive approximately \$.5 million which was essentially everything that was asked for. He stated that DWR would like to see the coordination agreement completed and Salinas Valley Basin GSA was asking that the scope be amended stating that they were committed to completing the coordination agreement.

There was additional discussion among staff and the Board regarding the grant.

**RECEIVE ARROYO SECO GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY AGENCY GENERAL MANAGER'S STATUS REPORT**

General Manager Weeks stated that there were issues with the Salinas Valley Basin GSA and stated that City of Marina had submitted a lawsuit. He stated that the Department of Water Resources had a workshop in Paso Robles regarding GSPs and it was made clear that when there were two GSAs that there must be a coordination agreement prior to submittal of the Plan.

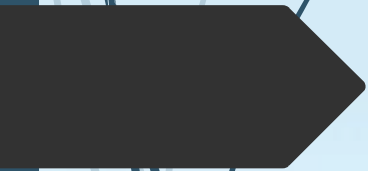

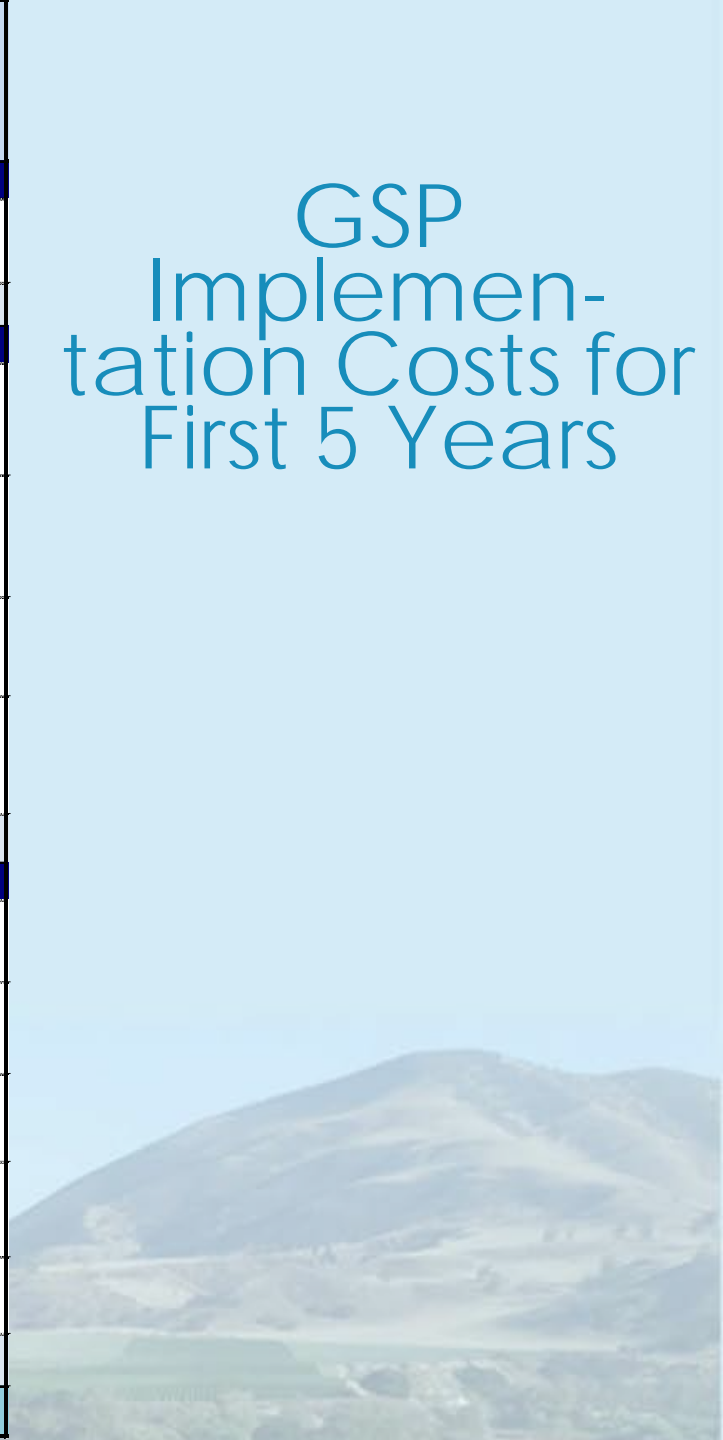

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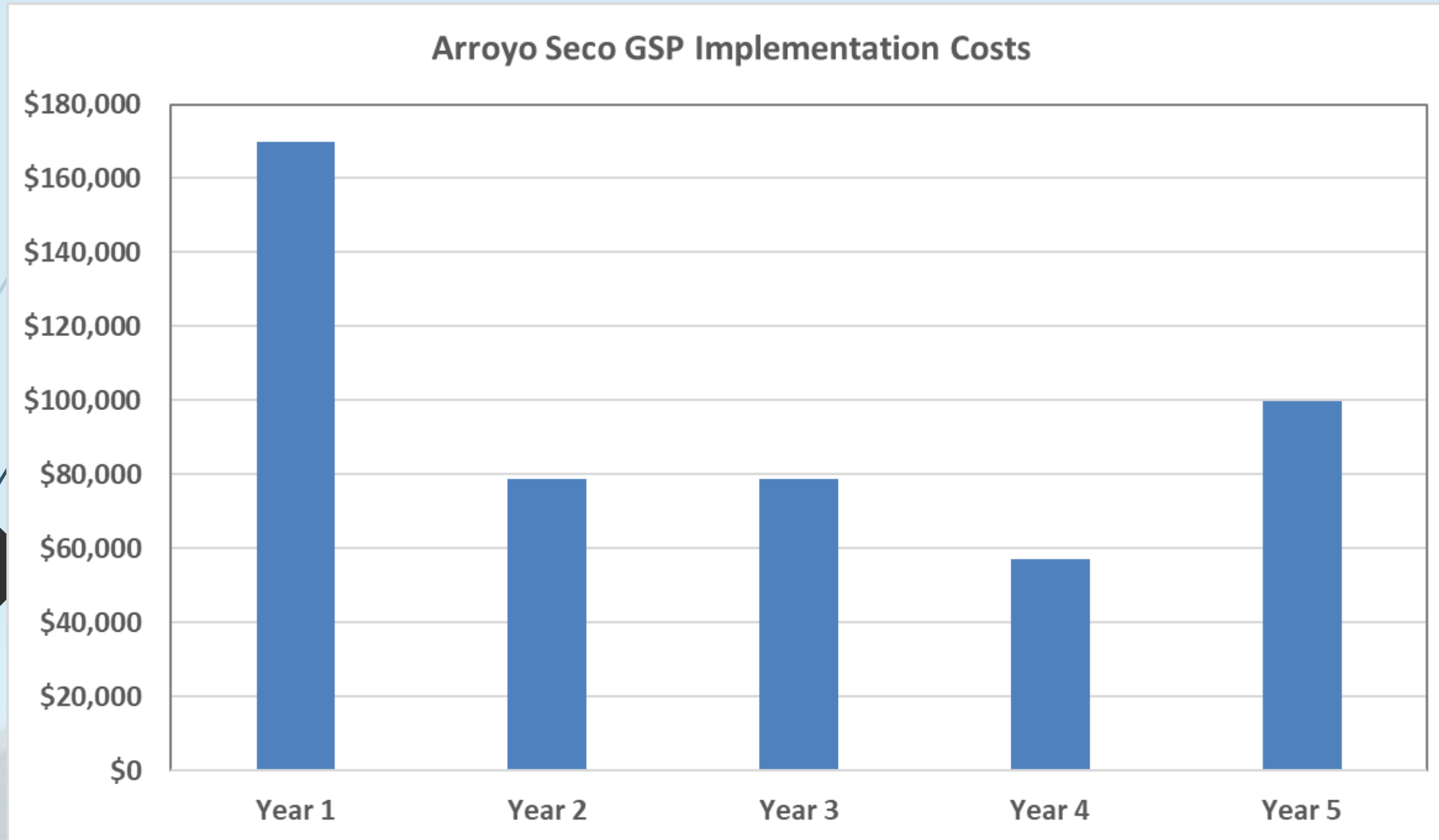

- DWR recommended funding list combined the ASGSA and SVBGSA grant applications

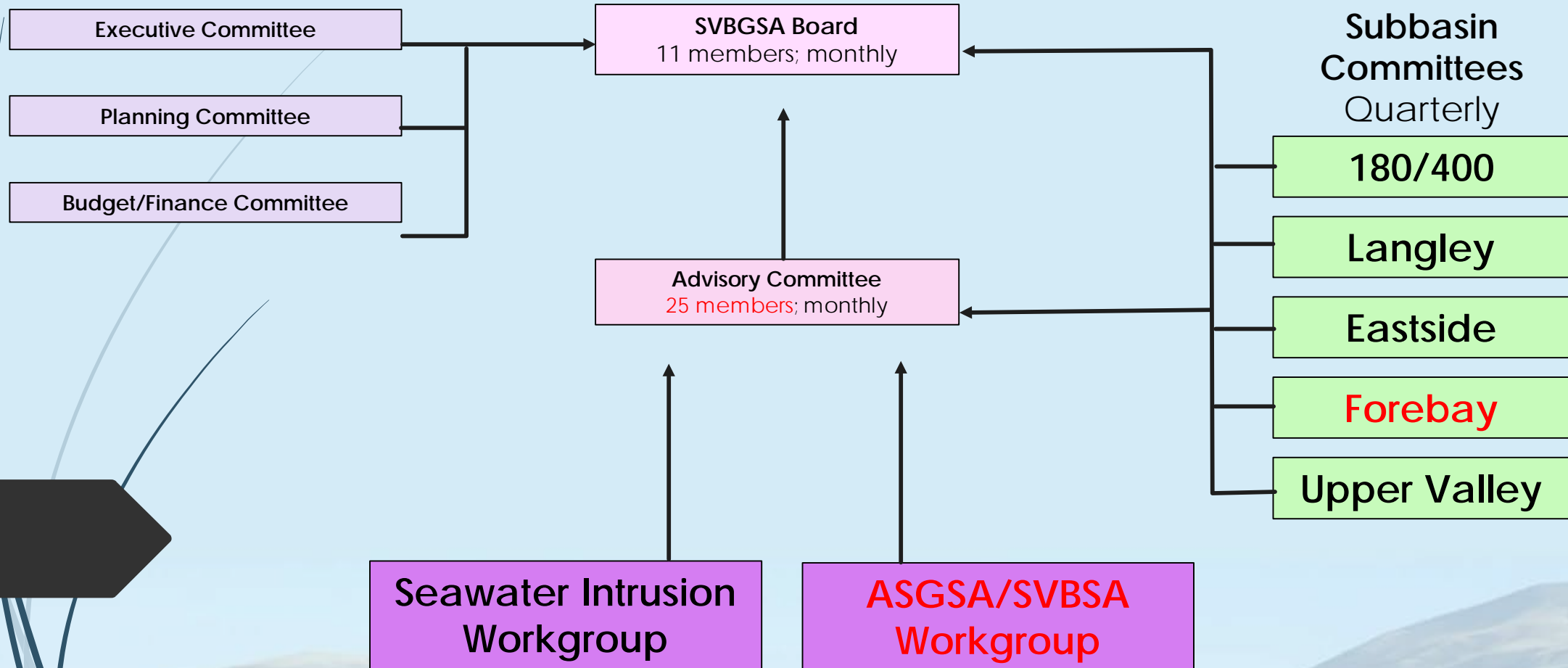
# DWR Grant Application Coordination

## *Component 3: Forebay Subbasin Management Area GSP Elements and Reservoir Reoperation Analysis*

*Implementing Agency: Arroyo Seco Basin GSA*

*This component involves preparing the relevant GSP sections that address the Arroyo Seco Management Area in the Forebay GSP. This component will be conducted by the ASBGSA with coordination between ASBGSA and SVBGSA. The tasks for this component mostly correspond to chapters in the GSP that are affected by including a Management Area following the outline recommended by DWR. Each task will complete its part of the GSP per the regulatory requirements. No costs to be reimbursed with grant funds for Component 3 may be incurred prior to the evidence of a notification to the public and DWR prior to initiating development of a GSP in compliance with California Code of Regulations, title 23, Section 350 et seq. (GSP Regulations) and Water Code Section 10727.8 being submitted to DWR's Project Manager.*
