Oral report was given by General Manager Weeks. He stated that the report did do what the Board wanted it to do. He stated that the Advisory Committee did take exception to include the forebay in the deep aquifer and would be taking the definition of the deep aquifer to the technical committee in order to clarify its definition. He also stated that it was important to highlight the steel head habitat and that the river should be unregulated.

Amy Woodrow, Monterey County Water Resources Agency, stated that they had provided the information to Montgomery & Associates as soon as they got the information.

Donna Meyers, Salinas Valley Basin Groundwater Sustainability Agency, stated that they did receive the data from the Monterey County Water Resources and stated that they hope that they get data in a more timely manner.
