All written comments that are not read into the record will be made part of the meeting minutes, provided that such comments are received prior to the end of the Agency meeting.

1. Public Comments: none

2. Approval of Minutes of the February 12, 2020 meeting:

Action: Michael Griva made a motion to approve minutes, Jerry Lohr seconded it; and motion passed.

3. Update on the Coordination Agreement with SVBGSA: Curtis Weeks gave an update to the Committee informing them that a sub-committee meeting was scheduled for 3/13/20 to continue discussion of the Coordination Agreement.

4. Update on the DWR Round 3 Grant: Curtis Weeks gave an update as the status of the grant application, and basically that there was no status as of this date. Discussion took place as to funding and the need for the coordination agreement.

5. General Manager's Report: Curtis Weeks gave an update on the status of finalizing the draft Implementation Section of the GSP. Discussion took place regarding the inclusion of a regulatory fee for implementation of the administration work. The fee would be structured similar to the administrative fee imposed by the SVBGSA. Discussion took place regarding the timeline for finalization of the GSP. Curtis stated that he hoped to have a draft by the end of April, with a 'final final' the end of July for approval by the ASGSA BOD.
