REGULATIONS FOR FIREWORK STANDS

In order to provide a reasonably safe establishment for the sale of approved *"Safe and Sane"* fireworks, the following rules shall be observed and enforced:

THESE REGULATIONS SHALL BE POSTED IN A CONSPICUOUS LOCATION INSIDE THE FIREWORKS STAND.

1. Each fireworks stand shall have a Safety Officer who is a responsible adult and has attended the annual safety orientation. They shall receive a signed card and have in their possession at all times, showing they successfully completed the training. There shall be at least one qualified Safety Officer working in the fireworks stand at all times while the stand is being used for the sale of Safe and Sane fireworks, including loading and unloading of fireworks.
2. No Safe and Sane fireworks shall be sold except during the permitted times between 12:00 PM and 10:00 PM on the 28th of June, 9:00 AM to 10:00 PM on the 29th of June through the 3rd of July, and 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM on the 4th of July each year. Each stand shall have a license from the California State Fire Marshal (CSFM) prominently displayed. A retail license shall authorize the retail sales of Safe and Sane fireworks.
3. **No fireworks shall be sold to anyone under the age of 16 years old.**
4. No person other than the permitted organization shall operate the fireworks stand for which the permit is issued or share or otherwise participate in the profits of the operation for such stand. No person other than the individuals who are members of the permitted organization shall sell or otherwise participate in the sale of Safe and Sane fireworks.
5. **No person under the age of 18 shall sell or handle for sale any classifications of fireworks or shall be within the stand.**
6. **NO SMOKING** signs shall be posted at conspicuous locations. Smoking shall be prohibited within 25 feet of all fireworks stands.
7. All Safe and Sane fireworks shall be retained or stored at the approved location of the fireworks stand, and in no event shall fireworks, other than those which have been sold, be removed from the approved fireworks stand location to any other place within the City. Any relocation of a fireworks stand shall be subject to prior approval by the fire chief.
8. Fireworks stands may only be located on property zoned for commercial or industrial uses.

9. No fireworks stand shall be located within 25 feet of any other building or within 50 feet of any gasoline station, fuel pump, storage tank, generator, or bulk plant.
10. Fireworks stands shall be located at least 100 feet apart from any other fireworks stand.
11. Fireworks stands shall comply with the provisions of the Building Code as determined by and at the discretion of the building official. All fireworks stands shall be erected under the supervision of the building official. The building shall require that stands be constructed in a manner which will reasonably ensure safety of attendants and patrons.
12. Temporary electrical wiring within the fireworks stand shall be prohibited.
13. Electrically powered equipment shall be located at least 10 feet from the fireworks stand.
14. Each stand shall have at least two approved exits located at opposite ends of the stand. Exits must be clearly marked and remain unobstructed. At no time shall an exit be locked from the outside when the booth is occupied.
15. Each fireworks stand shall be provided with a 2A:10B:C or 2.5 gallon "water type" fire extinguisher approved by the fire chief, in good working order, and easily accessible for use in case of fire. Such fire extinguishers shall be kept at or immediately near the fireworks stand.
16. There shall be no drinking or possession of alcoholic beverages or the consumption of any medications or substances that can impair judgment or coordination in or about the fireworks stand or storage site at any time.
17. All weeds and/or combustible materials shall be cleared from the location of the firewood stand, to a distance of at least 30 feet.
18. When the fireworks stand is not being used for the sale and/or display of fireworks, all fireworks shall be stored in a manner consistent with one of the following:
 - Within a reinforced, heavy metal, fully enclosed container, walk-in type drop box, or its equivalent, as approved by the fire code official; **or** returned daily to the licensed fireworks wholesaler for storage at an approved location.
19. It is unlawful to discharged or ignite firework of any type within 25 feet of a fireworks stand.
20. Fireworks stands shall be removed from the temporary locations by noon on the 10th day of July, and all accompanying litter shall be cleared from the locations by this time.
21. A City approved safety brochure shall be given to customers during every sale of fireworks.

Fireworks stands shall be inspected for compliance with all regulations in an effort to ensure public safety. Failure to comply with regulations could result in permit being immediately suspended or revoked, and possible future disqualification of the permitted person or organization from obtaining operational permits in the future.
